Start your enrollment application

- You will receive a welcome E-mail within 48 hours
- Be sure to save: HCC ID, P-Number or a D-Number (if you are assigned one)

Apply for & accept financial aid

HCC School Code: 010422

- Log into your preferred email account to check your status (financial aid can take around 4 weeks to show)
- Submit any additional documents (like tax forms) as needed
- Accept or decline financial aid award

- This is where you'll upload your meningitis shot record (under the age of 22) register, and check financial aid
- Review and take action on the HCC Policy Checklist and On-Boarding Checklist

Send proof of Meningitis vaccination

- This is required for all college students under the age of 22
- Meningitis vaccinations last for only five years
- Exemption Religious, Medical and Online students
- If you cannot get a meningitis shot, talk to an HCC Enrollment staff

 You must complete the necessary checklist items and NSO before meeting with an advisor.







Meet with an HCC Advisor

- Students can speak to an advisor once they have completed the New Student Orientation (NSO)
- Advisor can help answer any question and help you figure out which classes to take
