Dual Credit

Students demonstrating college readiness through a State of Texas approved college placement test can earn dual credit by taking an approved college class offered at high school, HCC campus or online.

What's the Texas Success Initiative?

The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) is the statue that requires all Texas public institutions of higher education to determine the readiness of all non-exempt, entering undergraduate students to enroll in freshman-level academic courses (see TEC, 51.336).

If students do not qualify with ACT, PSAT, SAT or STARR scores, students are required to take the Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2)

Students will connect with their high school counselor or dual credit liaison to take the TSIA2 assessment.

What's is Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0?

The Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2) is the assessment instrument used to determine college readiness for non-exempt students, as required by the Texas Success Initiative.

TSIA2 helps determines whether students are ready for college-level coursework in English Language Arts and Reading (ELAR) and Mathematics.

TSIA2 Prep Bootcamp Initiative

HCC P-16 collaborated with the Division of College Readiness and HISD to offer a day of learning for TSIA2 Prep Bootcamps dedicated to preparing students for the TSIA2 assessment. The P-16 department worked with content experts in various departments to develop a curriculum that focuses on the eight TSIA2 areas of assessment.

The TSIA2 Prep Bootcamps include 3 instructional sessions covering the Reading, Writing and Math sections based on the TSIA2 exam subsections.

Students receive very focused instruction on a subject and specifically in the area that they need help.

TSIA2 Prep Bootcamp Instruction

TSIA2 eight areas of assessment covered at Bootcamps include:

- Quantitative Reasoning
- Algebraic Reasoning
- Geometric & Spatial Reasoning
- Statistical & Probabilistic Reasoning
- Literary Text Analysis
- Essay Elements and Synthesis in Writing and Revision
- Informational Text Analysis & Synthesis
- Sentence Revision, Editing and Completion



Getting your students started in EdReady

GETTING YOUR STUDENTS STARTED IN EDREADY hccs.edready.org

Step 1 - Navigate to hccs.edready.org and click **Get Started**.

Step 2 - After creating their account, students will receive an email confirmation with an activation link

Step 3 - After logging in, students will be prompted to enter a **goal key**.

Please note that goal keys are case sensitive. Students only need to enter the goal key one time to add it to their dashboard.

Step 4 - There is a walkthrough video and a student quick start guide at the

bottom of the hccs.edready.org main page if they need assistance.
