The Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) in Healthcare Management is designed to enhance any health science associate of applied science degree. The BAS prepares students for career advancement or entry-level healthcare managerial positions. The degree program enables working allied health professionals to advance their career by focusing on leadership skills, knowledge and credentials in the healthcare management field.

Online courses rely on technology for the delivery of the course as well as the completion of assignments, etc. Students interested in online courses need access to a compatible computer or mobile device, high-speed internet connection, a webcam and microphone. To be successful, students taking online courses must have basic computer skills and be competent with office productivity applications and the use of websites.

PROGRAM ADMISSION CRITERIA

Fifteen applicants will be offered admission in the Fall cohort.

- An applicant must have an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Occupational Therapy Assistant, Physical Therapy Assistant, Radiography, Medical Laboratory, Histologic Technician, Nuclear Medicine, Dental Hygiene, Health Information Technology, or any healthcare related field pending program director approval. Students with AAS degrees in allied healthcare from Houston community college are awarded priority admission. Prior college-level coursework must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- HCC Coleman College health science AAS students, within two semesters of graduation, are
 eligible to apply. However, the associate degree must be conferred prior to official acceptance
 into the BAS Healthcare Management program.

If the applicant is not a current HCC student and applies to the BAS program, then provide HCC
with official transcripts that show their conferred health science AAS degree. The AAS degree
must be issued from an institution that is regionally accredited by an agency that is recognized
by HCC.

HOW DO I SUBMIT MY APPLICATION?

1. Apply to HCC.

If you are new to college or transferring, your first step is to become an HCC Eagle by submitting a free admissions application. To obtain the HCC student ID number, please create a profile and complete an application at www.applytexas.org/. You will receive a welcome email response within 48 hours. Be sure to save your ID number or P-number/D-number (if you are assigned one). Do not submit another application if you already have an HCC student ID or have previously applied at any point. Multiple HCC applications or ID numbers are not allowed.

2. Apply for financial aid.

All students should apply for financial aid immediately after applying for admission to HCC. Filling out a financial aid application is the first step in learning your options to pay for college. HCC accepts financial aid applications throughout the year, submitting an application early will give you a better chance of securing aid.

3. Meet with an advisor.

5. Complete a BAS Healthcare Management program application.

In addition to the HCC application, submit a BAS Healthcare Management program application here.*
A complete application will include:

- unofficial transcript(s).
- an essay of 300 to 400 words, elaborating on your motivation for pursuing this program, your objectives for completing it and the ways in which your personal or professional background aligns with your aspirations and interests. The essay will be evaluated based on its content and clarity of expression.

6. Submit official transcripts.

Official, sealed unopened transcript(s) must be submitted directly to HCC from the issuing college or university attended. *If you have completed your courses at HCC, you do not need to submit a transcript.*

There are two ways to submit an official transcript from your previous institution:

Foreign Transcripts: All foreign transcripts must be evaluated for US equivalency and course-by-course by an approved evaluating agency. To find a list of approved evaluation companies, please visit <u>Foreign transcript/ Foreign Credit Evaluators</u>. The official evaluation report must be submitted to HCC.

Medical and health services managers may manage an entire facility, a specific clinical area or department, or a medical practice for a group of physicians and are responsible for planning, directing and coordinating services. Employment opportunities may be found in medical offices, clinics, hospitals, nursing homes and group medical practices.

The median annual wage for medical and health services managers is approximately \$101,532* with the Houston area labor market expecting approximately 1,067* annual employment openings.
