ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in a healthcare, medically related field, or business management with a cumulative GPA 2.5
- Current HCC Coleman College AAS students that are within two semesters of graduation may apply to the program
- You must have a conferred AAS degree upon entering the program
- If the applicant is not a current HCC student or graduate and applies to the BAS program, then the AAS degree must be conferred from an institution that is regionally accredited by an agency recognized by HCC
